
## Technology Adoption Survey

**Construction estimating is seeing a surge in technology solutions from cloud-based document management to model-based takeoff and even advanced data analytics.**





However most contractors don't have the time or funding to adopt every new tool. Estimators must evaluate the benefits of each and decide where to prioritize their investment.

# How Satisfied Are Contractors With Their Investment?



While this is only a small sample of contractors, we can already start to see some interesting trends. Bidding solutions is the tool that contractors are most likely to have invested in, and it's also the tool that is offering the most value, according to our survey. In comparison, tools for analyzing historical data to improve the accuracy of conceptual estimating has had limited uptake so far, with mixed results.
